



### EUROPEAN BUFFET | ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

It is necessary that each participating school brings along, or prepares in the school's kitchen, 3 specialties of their country, about 20 tasting portions per dish. Delegations should bring along most of their ingredients.

Kitchen equipment such as refrigerators will be available on arrival and at your disposal. Our training kitchen and equipment will be available for participants, for preparation of all dishes including warm ones. There are several supermarkets in the school area where you can buy necessary ingredients.

Please notify us of the specific ingredients or equipment that you may need in order to confirm their availability by filling in "REQUEST FOR INGREDIENTS" and sending an e-mail to: [projects@ktm.lt](mailto:projects@ktm.lt)

Certain basic ingredients like flour, rice, milk, butter will be provided by our school. The organizers will provide you with utensils and equipment for the preparation and serving of the dishes. However, you may also use your own utensils and tableware.

We expect all delegations to send us their recipes in the ENGLISH language, while listing all ingredients for the dishes offered at the European Buffet and highlighting related allergens.

For organizational improvement purposes, the European Buffet will be held over a period of two days, on December 5th and 6th. Each participating school will have one set table with tablecloth, ready for service. On December 5th, some schools will have to prepare their dishes, the remaining schools will cook on December 6th. On Monday December 4th, organizers will inform all schools on their respective participations and cuisine turns.



## **CULTURAL SHOW AND PERFORMANCES / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

All participating schools, will prepare a cultural performance with traditional songs, dance, music or play of a Christmas theme.

Each school's performance should last from 8 to 10 minutes.

## **PARADE / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Please remember to bring along your country flag for the parade. Note that flags should be standard-sized.

At least one participant of each delegation, but preferably all, shall be dressed in traditional national clothing or national Christmas festive costume. Since the parade will take place along the city streets, please consider that Klaipėda weather conditions at the beginning of December are unpredictable and it often rains or snows, although we hope the weather will stay dry.

After the parade we will arrive at the school for the Exhibition opening of Christmas in Europe Klaipėda Edition 2023.

## **EXHIBITION / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

The stands will be located in the school's gymnasium. The organizers are going to provide one stand per each participating institution.

The stand will be equipped with the following items:

1. one electric socket 5A (European standard)
2. one table
3. two chairs
4. one small Christmas tree (without Christmas decoration)

A box with basic equipment for decoration work (scissors, scotch tape, paper towel and etc.) will be provided for each delegation.

Christmas traditions of your country must be presented in the stand. Please find some recommendations in the AEHT guidelines:

1. Some hand out sheets with Christmas recipe in English, preferably of the dish you are representing in the stand.
2. Food and drinks for tasting. Note that alcoholic drinks and spirits will have limitations in distribution for age limit.
3. Christmas greetings in your native language with translation into English.
4. What dishes people usually have on Christmas Eve and on Christmas Day.
5. Other interesting information associated with Christmas in your country.
